## Term 2 – 2019 School **Events**

Please take note of the events below and ensure you and your child participate fully.

- Weekly tests will be every Friday and Monthly tests will be given every last Friday of the Month. For computer lessons, only monthly tests will be conducted.
- Simoko Trust school is proud to celebrate the following public holidays this term: Saturday 25th May 2019 - Africa Freedom Day, Monday 1st July 2019 and Tuesday 2nd July 2019 - Heroes & Unity Days.
- Educational Tour at Beracah Gardens on Friday 7th June 2019. Children will be required to pay K150.00 for transport, snacks and other logistics at the venue. All learners must be in full school uniform on this day
- Our mid-term break will run from Monday 1st July 2019 to Friday 5th July 2019
- Intra-school Sports Day: Friday 12th July 2019 at Levy Mwanawasa Stadium. All our parents are invited and encouraged to come and support us on this day.
- Tests will commence on 22nd July 2019 and end on 30th July 2019.
- Closing day is on Thursday 1st August 2019
- Open (Consultation) day is on 2nd August
- Term 3 begins on Monday 2nd September
- Reporting time for all pupils is 07:20hrs, and classes begin at 07:30hrs. Knocking off time on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesday and Thursdays

is 15:30hrs and 12:30hrs on Fridays. Note that afternoon activities are important and no child will be picked up before the stipulated time. Children brought to school after 08:00hrs will be sent back home. Similarly, picking up children one hour or more late will attract a K50 charge for an hour late and a further K50 for a subsequent hour late.

#### Clubs

Tuesday afternoon, from 14:00hrs to 15:30hrs, has been set aside for clubs. The following are clubs operating in the school: HIV/AIDS Awareness, Poetry & Drama, Music, Debate, Conservation, JETS, Art & Sculpture and Literacy Club.

Parents are encouraged to make use of the communication books as they enhance triangular interaction of pupils, teachers and parents. If a parent decides to send a different person to pick up the child, the person should be introduced to the School Authorities in advance otherwise the School will not release the child to that new per-

#### **School Rules**

In order to create a conducive environment for learners; parents and pupils alike are encouraged to observe all school rules for an effective and efficient running of the school. Copies of the school rules can be obtained from the Administration office.

#### Our school buses

Children using the bus must observe the rules of the bus, e.g. no eating or drinking in the bus, no standing, no sticking out heads or limbs from the window, etc. Please note that the bus fares are paid monthly and cannot be paid in installments. Children with arrears after the first week of the month will not be picked up.

## **School Uniforms**

Pupils must report to school every Monday to Thursday in correct uniform and every Friday in correct P.E Attire. A child without proper Uniform will be sent back.

## **Personal belongings**

To ensure that children do not lose their personal belongings, parents are urged to ensure that each child's belongings are clearly labeled with their names. Labels or names should never be written in front or at the back or on the side but can neatly be written inside the School uniforms, jerseys, PE attire and head socks as they are not part of school uniform but merely meant to identify the owners of those garments.

#### **Homework Policy**

Class teachers have been asked to issue homework on a daily basis to the children. Parents need to check books of their children and sign to ensure that this is the case.

### Cafeteria

The school cafeteria payments are monthly and expire on the Friday of the last week of the month. Payments are to be made in the first week of the month and in full. This is to help us plan and manage better for the children. Half payments and day payments may be accepted, however, no child will be allowed to eat on credit.
